

MILWAUKEE CHORISTERS PRODUCE NEW CD

Moments is the title of the Milwaukee Choristers' newest compact disc recording. The just-released CD is the second by the community chorus, and features selections from recent spring concerts directed by Dr. James B. Kinchen, Jr.

The nearly 66 minutes of music on the CD includes 24 selections that mirror a typical Choristers' concert in their diversity. Among the selections are "Te Deum" by Franz Josef Haydn; works by Giovanni da Palestrina and Hans Hassler; "A Girl's Garden" from Randall Thompson's "Frostiana"; James Erb's popular choral arrangement of "Shenandoah;" two spirituals, including the late Moses Hogan's arrangement of "The Battle of Jericho;" and seven selections from Jerome Kern's and Oscar Hammerstein II's "Showboat," arranged by Jackie O'Neill.

The CD includes notes regarding the selections prepared by Dr. Kinchen. A full listing of the selections on the CD is posted at the chorus website - www.milwaukeechoristers.org.

The cost of the CD is \$15, plus shipping and handling.
