

**MILWAUKEE CHORISTERS
SPRING CONCERT SET FOR MAY 20/21
AT CARDINAL STRITCH UNIVERSITY**

The Milwaukee Choristers will conclude their 2004/2005 concert season when they present “That Which Comes From The Heart” on Friday, May 20 and Saturday, May 21, at 8 p.m. in the CFA Theater at Cardinal Stritch University. It will mark the Choristers’ first performance in the Stritch theater.

Advance tickets for the concert are available at \$12 per person. The cost for individual tickets purchased at the door will be \$15. Other options include a senior ticket for \$10 and a student ticket for \$5. Tickets may be purchased from members of the chorus or by calling 414/354-1933.

Dr. James B. Kinchen, Jr., director of choral activities at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside, who has been conductor of the Choristers since 1993, has put together a varied program of music inspired by the ancient proverb, “Out of the heart flow the issues of life.”

The entire program is posted on the chorus website, www.milwaukeechoristers.org. It includes works by Johannes Brahms, Francis Poulenc, J.S. Bach, Randall Thompson and John Rutter. The Choristers will also perform Victor Young’s 1954 selection, *When I Fall In Love*, a standard which gained new popularity because of its use in the hit movie, *Sleepless in Seattle*. In addition, Dr. Kinchen has programmed two numbers – *Bring Him Home* and *Do You Hear The People Sing*-- from the Broadway musical, *Les Miserables*.

Soprano Ana L. de la Cuesta Gerlach, a native of Cuba, will perform a flute solo version of *Corazon (Heart)*, written by Cuban composer Eduardo Sanchez de Fuentes. Her husband, baritone Fred Gerlach, will recite the lyrics of *Corazon* in Spanish and English.

All concert seating is general admission.
