It's history time again. My mom was going through some documents and found the acceptance letter (and all original paperwork) my grandfather received from the Farm Security Administration for a home in Greendale. It reads:

May 13, 1938.

Dear Sir:

We are pleased to notify you that you have been qualified for a home in Greendale. Enclosed is a rental certificate which is to be presented for house assignment. Will you kindly call at the management office in the Administration Building at Greendale on

May 17, 1938 between 9:30 AM and 12:00 Noon

and be prepared to make your selection and sign your lease. No deposit will be required; however, rent for one month must be paid in full before you move in.

It is important that you do not come out for your assignment except at the above-stated time and date. If you cannot come at this time please telephone Mr. Nelson, Greenfield 1770, to arrange for another appointment.

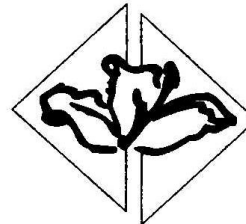
