Use of Electricity and Water

Your lease states the flat rate charges for use of electricity and water. The electric rates include reasonable domestic use and charges covering the rental and maintenance of the electric range and refrigerators. The amount of electric current allowed each household is ample for your lighting, cooking and refrigeration. Families who are wasteful of electricity will be notified and if their excess use is not curtailed they will be charged extra.

The water rate covers normal requirements as well as meter reading service. Greendale is one of the few municipali-

ties in Wisconsin to have a municipal water softening plant. The softened artesian water will be available by about the middle of June. Its use will result in a marked saving of soap.

It is to your own interest not to be wasteful in the use of electricity and water.

Two spare 15 ampere fuses have been placed in your fuse box. Burnt-out fuses can be turned in for new ones at the Management office. Please refer to the directions posted in the fuse box.

Speed Limit

Your observance of the posted speed limit of 20 miles per hour will go far in eliminating traffic accidents.
