The diverse program he has put together for the Spring Concert ranges from *Te Deum* by Franz Josef Haydn; *Sicut Cervus* by Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina; *Alleluia* and *Choose Something Like A Star* by Randall Thompson to such selections as the late Moses Hogan's popular arrangement of *The Battle Of Jericho*; Betty Jacobson's *Blessed Be God*; the James Erb arrangement of *Shenandoah*; and a medley of selections from George Gershwin's *Porgy and Bess* as arranged by Ed Lojeski.
