

MARIE SANDER has long been active in Milwaukee music circles, performing as a substitute flutist with the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, the Milwaukee Chamber Orchestra and the Milwaukee Ballet Orchestra. She has also performed with the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra and the Green Bay Symphony. Ms. Sander is an original member of Present Music, a seven-member ensemble ranked as one of the leading contemporary music groups in the United States, now in its twenty-seventh year. With Present Music she has toured Japan, Turkey and China, as well as throughout the United States. Ms. Sander studied with Geoffrey Gilbert and Robert Goodberg. In November 1999, she was a featured soloist for the John Downey Music Festival in London, England, performing on flute, alto flute and bass flute. She has appeared as a guest artist on Wisconsin Public Radio and can be heard in numerous recordings with the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, Present Music, and twentieth century composers. In addition to her private studio, Ms. Sander has taught at the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music, Alverno College and Concordia University.
